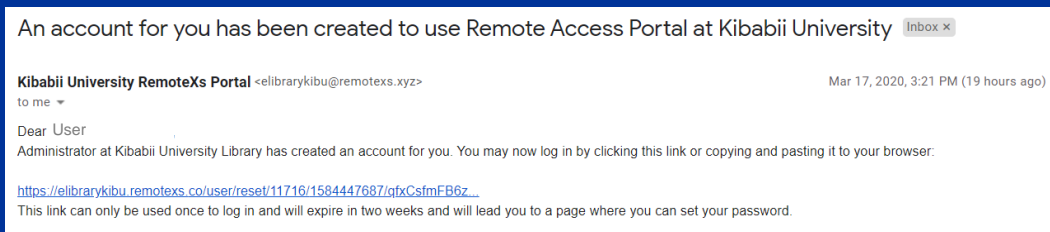

## USER GUIDE

### Step 1: Activate your Account

A user account will be created by library systems administrator and an email will be sent to you with instructions to **activate your account** and creation of **login password**. **Click on the link**.



### Step 2: Create Password

#### Criteria

- Password must have at least 8 character(s).
- Password must have at least 1 symbol(s).
- Password must have at least 1 letter(s).
- Password must have at least 1 digit(s).
- Password must have upper and lower case letters.


